These classes are for breeds formally recognised by the Kennel Club. No Challenge Certificate/Reserve Challenge Certificate/Junior Warrant winners are eligible for entry.

- 1. Any Variety Puppy (6-12 months)
- 2. Any Variety Veteran (over 7 years)
- 3. Any Variety Gundog
- 4. Any Variety Hound
- 5. Any Variety Toy/Utility
- 6. Any Variety Terrier
- 7. Any Variety Working/Pastoral
- 8. Any Variety Open
- 9. Best Junior Handler (open to any young person under the age of 18)

All *unbeaten dogs* from the above classes will be presented to the judge for the award of **Best in Show** and **Reserve Best in Show** after judging of novelty classes has been completed. *See Rule 4.*

Novelty Classes (Open to any breed)

- 10. Dog judge would most like to take home
- 11. Dog with the waggiest tail
- 12. Prettiest bitch
- 13. Most handsome dog
- 14. Dog in best condition
- 15. Most appealing eyes
- 16. Best of friends (combination of 2 dogs)
- 17. Any Variety Cross Breed
- 18. Fancy Dress

Judging starts at 12pm - Dogs registration opens at 10am.

Entries taken on the day - £2.50 for first class and 50p for subsequent classes

All proceedings will go to the Royal Veterinary College Animal Care Trust.

All dogs must be 6 months old on day of the show.

Rules & Regulations

- 1. All dogs must be at least **6 months old** on the day of the show (Born on or before 6th February 2023).
- 2. No Challenge Certificate/Reserve Challenge Certificate/Junior Warrant winners are eligible for entry to the show.
- 3. Only undocked dogs and legally docked dogs may be entered for exhibition at this show.
- 4. For clarity, an unbeaten dog is a dog which has not been placed behind any other dog in their class (or classes). If a dog wins one class e.g. AV Gundog but is placed second (or below) in e.g. AV Open, they would be regarded as a beaten dog and would not be eligible to compete for the title of Best in Show or Reserve Best in Show.
- 5. The judges decision is final.
- 6. Entries will be accepted until 11am on the day of the show.
- 7. Judging will commence at **12pm.**
- 8. Entry Fees: £2.50 for the first class entered and 50p for subsequent class entries thereafter.
- 9. **DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS:** your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather. If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage.
- 10. Pedigree classes are open to all breeds formally recognised by the Kennel Club. For more information please see https://www.thekennelclub.org.uk/search/breeds-a-to-z/
- 11. Novelty classes are open to any pedigree and non-pedigree breeds.
- 12. 1st to 4th rosettes will be awarded in each class.
