Pedigree Classes

These classes are for breeds formally recognised by the Kennel Club. No Challenge Certificate/Reserve Challenge Certificate/Junior Warrant winners are eligible for entry.

- 2. Any Variety Veteran (over 7 years)
- 3. Any Variety Hound
- 4. Any Variety Toy
- 5. Any Variety Utility
- 6. Any Variety Terrier
- 7. Any Variety Working
- 8. Any Variety Pastoral
- 9. Retriever (Golden) Open
- 10. Retriever (Labrador) Open
- 11. Cocker Spaniel Open
- 12. Any Variety Gundog
- 13. Any Variety Open

All *unbeaten dogs* from the above classes will be presented to the judge for the award of **Best in Show** and **Reserve Best in Show** after judging of pedigree classes has been completed. *See Rule 4.*

Novelty Classes (Open to any breed)

- 14. Junior Handling (open to any young person under the age of 18)
- 15. Dog judge would most like to take home
- 16. Dog with the waggiest tail
- 17. Prettiest bitch
- 18. Most handsome dog

- 21. Best of friends (combination of 2 dogs)
- 22. Any Variety Cross Breed

Rules & Regulations

General

- 1. All dogs must be at least 6 months old on the day of the show (Born on or before 10th February 2025).
- 2. No Challenge Certificate/Reserve Challenge Certificate/Junior Warrant winners are eligible for entry to the show
- 3. Only undocked dogs and legally docked dogs may be entered for exhibition at this show.
- 4. For clarity, an unbeaten dog is a dog which has not been placed behind any other dog in their class (or classes). If a dog wins one class e.g. AV Veteran but is placed second (or below) in e.g. AV Hound, they would be regarded as a beaten dog and would not be eligible to compete for the title of Best in Show or Reserve Best in Show.
- 5. The judges decision is final.
- 6. Entries will be accepted until 10am on the day of the show.
- 7. Judging will commence at 11am.
- 8. Entry Fees: £2.50 for the first class entered and 50p for subsequent class entries thereafter.
- 9. **DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS:** your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather. If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage.
- 10. 1st to 4th rosettes will be awarded in each class.
- 11. Prize Money: £20 for Best in Show and £10 for Reserve Best in Show.

Class Definitions

- 12. Pedigree classes are open to all breeds formally recognised by the Kennel Club. For more information please see https://www.thekennelclub.org.uk/search/breeds-a-to-z/
- 13. Class number 1 is for dogs who are between the ages of 6 months and 12 months.
- 14. Class number 2 is for dogs who are over 7 years of age.
- 15. Class number 3 is for dogs belonging to the Hound group. Examples include: *Beagle, Basset Hound, Dachshund, Saluki, Whippet.*
- 16. Class number 4 is for dogs belonging to the Toy group. *Examples include: Cavalier King Charles Spaniel, Chihuahua, Maltese, Pug, Yorkshire Terrier.*
- 17. Class number 5 is for dogs belonging to the Utility group. *Examples include: Bulldog, Chow Chow, Dalmatian, French Bulldog, Lhasa Apso, Miniature Schnauzer, Poodle.*
- 18. Class number 6 is for dogs belonging to the Terrier group. Examples include Border Terrier, Bull Terrier, Jack Russell, Scottish Terrier, Staffordshire Bull Terrier, West Highland White Terrier.
- 19. Class number 7 is for dogs belonging to the Working group. *Examples include Boxer, Dobermann, Great Dane, Newfoundland, Rottweiler, Siberian Husky.*
- 20. Class number 8 is for dogs belonging to the Pastoral group. *Examples include: Australian Shepherd, Rough Collie, Old English Sheepdog, Samoyed, Shetland Sheepdog, Corgi*
- 21. Class number 9 is exclusive to Retrievers (Golden).
- 22. Class number 10 is exclusive to Retrievers (Labrador).
- 23. Class number 11 is exclusive to Cocker Spaniels.
- 24. Class number 12 is for dogs belonging to the Gundog group. *Examples include: German Shorthaired Pointer, Hungarian Vizsla, Irish Setter, Pointer, Flat Coated Retriever.*
- 25. Class number 13 is open to any pedigree breed eligible for entry.
- 26. Class number 14 is for junior handlers under the age of 18 years.
- 27. Novelty classes are open to any pedigree and non-pedigree breeds.
- 28. If you are unsure of which group your dog falls under, please ask and we will help you with your entry.
